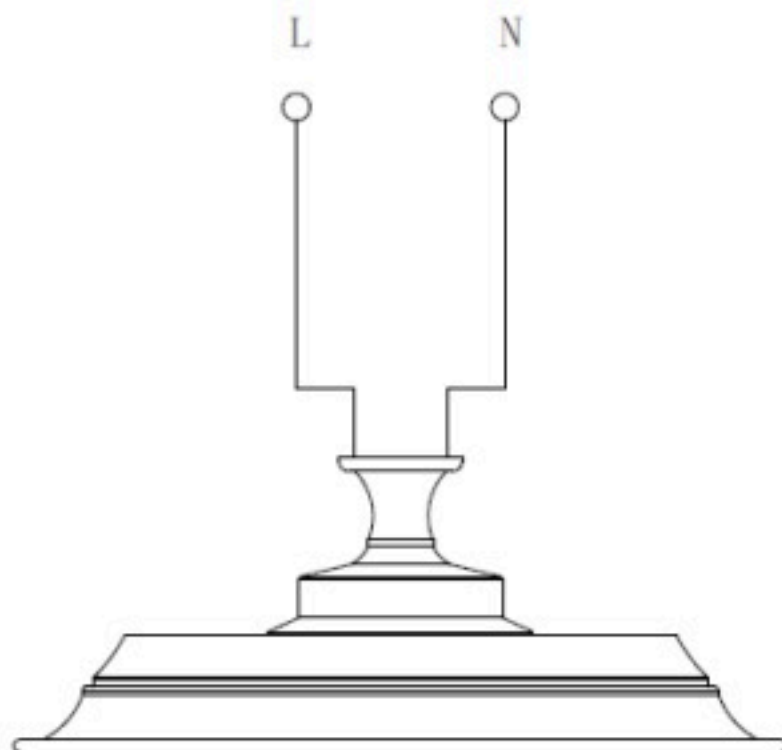


# 15" E26/E39 Low bay

## Installation Instructions

- 2** Screw the E26 lamp head into the lamp holder.



- 3** Reconnect directly to the existing lamp holder. Install new LED replacement lamp. Shown as on the left of the figure. Please make sure old socket is correctly grounded. and Turn on power at circuit breaker.

- Suitable for Dry or Damp locations.



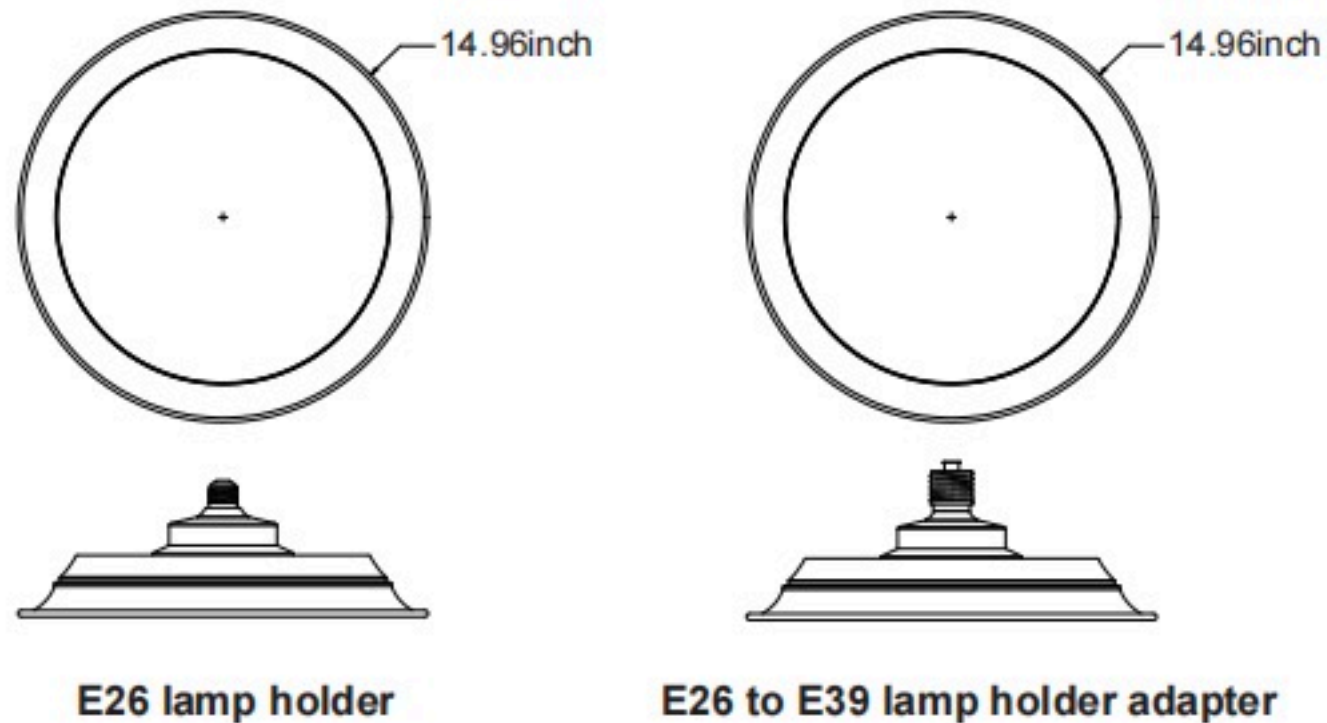
